Official Information Act request dated 30 January 2017

I am writing in response to your Official Information Act request received on 30 January 2017 requesting:

As of 31 January 2017, how many staff and/or contractors on a full time equivalent (FTE) basis are employed to develop policy or deliver services to Maori and Pacifica peoples (please itemise for both).

Superu does not develop policy, therefore we do not have any staff specifically engaged for policy development, nor do we deliver services directly to the public. Our purpose is to increase the use of evidence by people working across the social sector so that they can make better decisions to improve the lives of New Zealanders, New Zealand's communities, families and whānau.
