



## Superu Children and Families Research Fund – Funding agreement

---

### Contract period

The contract period will be 12 months from the date on which the recipient is able to access GUINZ data via the University of Auckland Remote Access Data Platform (RADP).

### Funding

Funding is paid in three installments: 50% on confirmation of data access via the RADP, 25% on progress report at six months and 25% on final deliverable.

### Data Access Protocols (DAP)

The project must be carried out in accordance with the DAP. All staff working on the project are familiar with the data, and have attended data workshops and are familiar with the DAC protocols. All staff working on the project have received approval and are listed in Schedule 3 of the application form. Non-approved personnel of the recipient may not be involved with the project.

### Record keeping

The recipient must maintain true and accurate records in connection with the funds provided and permit Superu to audit those records should the need arise.

### Intellectual property (IP)

Any IP developed as part of the funding will be owned by Superu from the date that the IP is created. Superu will provide the recipient a royalty-free licence to use the results of materials created under the funding.

### Final report

The final report must meet Superu's quality standards with regard to peer review and is not published by the recipient before it is published on the Superu (or an equivalent Government agency) website.

### Governance

The contract will be governed by New Zealand law and any disputes that cannot be settled by the parties will be mediated in New Zealand.

### Assignment/Sub-contracting

The contract may not be assigned or any party subcontracted to undertake the work without the express written permission of Superu.
